WHY CHOOSE MINMOW

- Sometimes referred to as no mow grass
- Great for small areas with minimal maintenance
- Used in garden beds or rock gardens as a tufts grass
- Very fine leaf texture
- Very slow to invade garden edging (if at all)



Cold Tolerant

Colour retention in cooler months



Good Traffic Tolerant

Not ideal as a thoroughfare



Required Sunlight

Min. 6 hours of direct sun daily

ABOUT THIS TURF

Minmow is a spreading grass that develops a unique freeform “clumping” appearance. Minmow is suited to sloping sites and batters where mowing is difficult or impractical. In such areas it may be left un-mown for a natural look.

Alternatively, Minmow can be used amongst boulders, ponds, stepping stones and in courtyards where a run-over with a mower or brush cutter once or twice a year will produce a more manicured appearance.

This dense, deep green variety is for those who are looking for the “wow” factor in the garden.
